HUMAN RIGHTS AFFECTED BY BLOCKADES (1,744 blockades) AND THOSE WHO DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE SOCIAL PROTESTS

RIGHT TO LIFE

- Death of patients for not allowing ambulances to pass.
- The blockades have generated confrontations that have resulted in attempts on the lives of several people.
- Negative effects on food production, distribution and
- sales.
- Shortages in supermarkets.
- Price increases.
- Need to dispose of food due to transportation and
- supply problems.

RIGHT TO HEALTH

RIGHT TO FOOD

- Shortage of medical supplies.
- Ambulances have not been allowed to pass.
- Difficult mobilization to health care centers puts the lives of patients at risk (especially cancer and renal failure patients).

 Vehicles are not allowed to pass freely within the city; illegal tolls are being imposed.

- Vehicles are not allowed to pass freely between municipalities and departments.
- Public transportation vehicles are vandalized and exclusive roads for their mobility are blocked.
- Transportation supplies are not allowed to enter.
- People are having difficulties returning to their homes.

RIGHT TO ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT

RIGHT TO MOBILITY

- The blockades generate that several economic sectors are extremely affected to continue developing.
- In addition to the social and economic crisis caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, there are serious effects of the national strike.
- Acts of vandalism, damage to the public transportation system, violent confrontations and road blockades have deeply affected our society and the productive sector.

RIGHT TO WORK

- People are finding it difficult to reach their workplaces.
- Due to the high economic losses in several sectors, layoffs and company closures have had to be made.

Because of the blockades, utility companies have reported that there is a possibility of running out of supplies to make water potable. The economic cost of one day of social protests is estimated at COP 484,000 million.

The mobilization of 700,000 tons of food has been stopped.

The cattle sector reports damages of about 8.2 million liters of milk per day and 40,320 heads of cattle and losses of COP 121,335 million.

94% of merchants surveyed by the National Federation of Merchants FENALCO have had to close during the day or have not open their stores; 34 % of the employees have arrived late or have not been able to attend their jobs; 5 % have been victims of vandalism attacks such as looting or damage to the facades of the commercial premises.

The pork industry is ceasing to produce close to 720 tons of pork per day.

The aquaculture sector estimates losses of 3,214 tons of fish per week at a cost of COP 32,000 million.

Affectations to the supply of Liquid Petroleum Gas required by a total of 12 million people in 1,050 municipalities throughout the country.

Increase in food prices between 10 % - 110 %, such as more than 12 million eggs, 16 thousand tons of chicken and 40 thousand tons of poultry feed

The Supply Center Cavasa reported that losses in two central supply centers reach up to COP 30-35 billion.

The Aqueduct, Water and Sewerage Company of the city of Bogota informed the public that there are problems in the transportation of supplies for making water potable.






